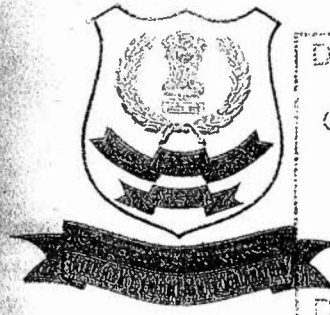

The UN General Assembly passed a Resolution in December, 1987, proclaiming 26th June of each year as the "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking". Thus, every year on 26th June, steps taken by the Government against drug abuse and illicit trafficking are highlighted, apart from spreading awareness on the subject.

2. It is therefore, requested that necessary directions may please issued to the concerned departments like Police, Education, Health and Family Welfare, Social Welfare, Jail, Youth and Sports, Excise and Prohibition to organize various programmes on 26th June, 2018. An illustrative list of programmes is as follows:

- > Awareness programmes in schools and colleges. ✓
- > Anti drug marches/Runs/Rally.
- > Public meetings among target groups vulnerable to drug abuse and HIV (street children, jail inmates, truck drivers, slum dwellers etc)
- > Seminars on drug abuse/drug trafficking.
- > Workshops to evolve new coordinated strategies for supply reduction and demand reduction by various enforcement agencies/NGOs.
- > Exhibition on drug abuse.
- > Flashing of SMS through various service providers on the subject.
- > Programmes on the subject by Doordarshan/All India Radio and other T.V. and Radio channel.
- > Display and distribution of banners, posters, pamphlets, hoardings, slide show in cinemas/public places.

3. Similar instructions may also be issued to District Magistrates and Collectors to observe the 26th June as the "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking".


